Personal data that we process

Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden processes your personal data because you use our services and / or because you provide them yourself.

Below is an overview of the personal data we process:

- List of contact details of the customer via an app
- Internet browser and device type
- Bank account number

Special and / or sensitive personal data that we process

Our website and / or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are younger than 16 years. Unless they have permission from parents or guardians. However, we cannot check if a visitor is older than 16. We encourage parents to be involved in the online activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children being collected without parental consent. For what purpose and on what basis we process personal data

Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Handling your payment
- Sending our newsletter and / or advertising brochure
- You can call or e-mail if necessary to carry out our services
- Inform you about changes to our services and products
- To deliver goods and services to you
- Pieterskerk Leiden Foundation analyzes your behavior on the website in order to improve the website and to tailor the range of products and services to your preferences.
- Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden follows your surfing behavior on various websites with which we tailor our products and services to your needs.



- Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden also processes personal data if we are legally obliged to do so, such as information that we need for our tax return.
- Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden does not store your personal data longer than is strictly necessary to realize the goals for which your data is collected.
- Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden will not sell your information to third parties and will only provide this information if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. With companies that process your data in our assignment, we conclude a processor agreement to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. The Pieterskerk Leiden Foundation remains responsible for these processing operations.
- Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden does not make decisions based on automated processing on matters that can have (significant) consequences for persons. These are decisions taken by computer programs or systems, without a person (for example an employee of Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden) sitting between them.

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

The Pieterskerk Leiden Foundation uses functional, analytical and tracking cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored in the browser of your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. The Pieterskerk Leiden Foundation uses cookies with a purely technical functionality. These ensure that the website works properly and that, for example, your preferred settings are remembered. These cookies are also used to make the website work well and to optimize it. In addition, we place cookies that keep track of your browsing habits so that we can offer customized content and advertisements.

On your first visit to our website we have already informed you about these cookies and asked permission for their placement.

You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it does not store cookies anymore. In addition, you can also delete all information previously saved via the settings of your browser.

Cookies are also placed on this website by third parties. These are for example advertisers and / or social media companies.

View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. You also have the right to withdraw your consent to the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden and you have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal information we have in your computer file to you or another organization mentioned by you.

You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for withdrawal of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to info@pieterskerk.com.

To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your ID with the request. Make your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and citizen service number (BSN) black in this copy. This is to protect your privacy. We respond as quickly as possible, but within four weeks, at your request.

The Pieterskerk Leiden Foundation would also like to point out that you have the opportunity to file a complaint with the national supervisory authority, the Dutch Data Protection Authority. How we protect personal data

The Pieterskerk Leiden Foundation takes the protection of your data seriously and takes appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorized

modification. If you have the impression that your data is not secure or there are indications of misuse, please contact our customer service or info@pieterskerk.com. Stichting Pieterskerk Leiden has taken the following measures to protect your personal data:

- Security software, such as a virus scanner and firewall.
- TLS (formerly SSL) We send your data via a secure internet connection. You can see this at the address bar 'https' and the padlock in the address bar.
- DKIM, SPF and DMARC are three internet standards that we use to prevent you from receiving e-mails on our behalf that contain viruses, are spam or are intended to obtain personal (login) data.
